## HEALTH SERVICES (FEES AND CHARGES) (AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS, 2002

In accordance with powers conferred by sections 13 of the Health Services (Fees) Law (2002 Revision) the Governor in Council makes the following regulations:

1. These regulations may be cited as the Health Services (Fees and Charges) Citation (Amendment) Regulations, 2002.

2. The Health Services (Fees and Charges) Regulations, 2002 are amended in regulation 5 (1) by repealing "4" and substituting "24".
