is to be treated as original matter for the purpose of this Law.".

- C. Subsection (1) of section 10 is hereby amended by deleting the whole of the last line thereof and substituting the words "keep the relevant customs entry forms as prima facie evidence of relief from customs duty and, if duty is subsequently charged, the fact is to be entered thereon by customs."
- D. The First Schedule of the Law is hereby amended as follows
 - (a) by deleting the item "Billiard and pool tables (other than coin operated) and connected equipment.";
 - (b) by deleting the items "Radios, stereo and tape machines.";
 - (c) by the addition in its proper alphabetical sequence a new item as follows —

"Intercommunication systems.".


