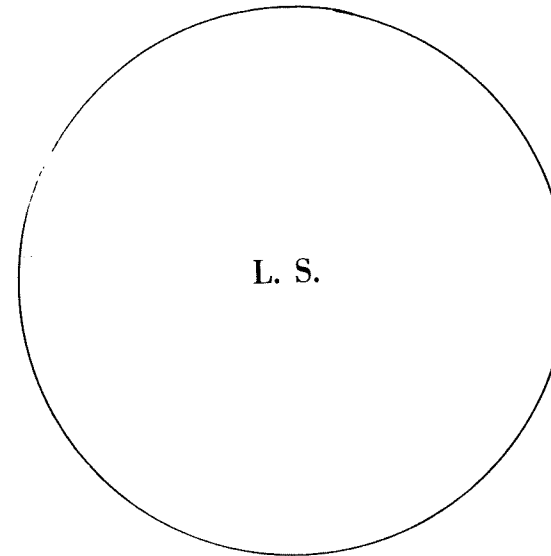

**A LAW to amend the Hotels Aid Law, 1976
(Law 6 of 1976).**

ENACTED by the Legislature of the Cayman Islands.

Short title.

1. This Law may be cited as the Hotels Aid (Amendment) Law, 1979.

Law 6 of 1976
amended.

2. The Hotels Aid Law 1976 is hereby amended —

A. by the addition of a new subsection to section 7 as follows —
 “(4) Any demise or device entered into or made after 1st March, 1979, whereby the availability of the whole or any part of a hotel for the accommodation of transient guests is in any way reduced or prejudiced operates to deprive such hotel of being the subject of any benefit under this Law and renders the proprietor thereof liable to pay in full, with interest at ten per centum per annum any customs duty which, but for the
