

- (b) adding at the end of the item headed "2. All other parts of the Islands", the following -

"Provided that, for a period of 3 years only from the date when the Hotels Aid (Amendment) Law, 1989 came into effect, the prescribed percentage shall be 0 p.c."

**A LAW  
TO AMEND THE HOTELS AID LAW, 1976  
(Law 6 of 1976)**

ENACTED by the Legislature of the Cayman Islands.

Short title	1. This Law may be cited as the Hotels Aid (Amendment) Law, 1989.
Amendment of s.2 of Law 6 of 1976	2. Section 2 of the Hotels Aid Law, 1976, in this Law referred to as the principal Law, is amended by deleting the words ",alter, reconstruct" where they appear in the definition of the word "construct".
Amendment of s.5	3. Section 5 of the principal Law is amended by inserting in subsection (1), between the words "be" and "in" where they appear in the first line, the words "submitted to the Secretary of the Licensing Board and shall be".
Amendment of 2nd Schedule	4. The Second Schedule to the principal Law is amended by -  (a) deleting from the item headed "1. West Bay Area - Grand Cayman", "10 p.c." where it appears in the right hand column of the penultimate line, and "5 p.c." where it appears in the right hand column of the last line, and substituting "Full Duty" in each case;
