A LAW TO AMEND THE INTERPRETATION LAW (CAP. 70)

ENACTED by the Legislative Assembly of the Cayman Islands.

Short title.

1. This Law may be cited as the Interpretation (Amendment) Law, 1985.

Amendment of s. 27 of Cap. 70.

- 2. Section 27 of the Interpretation Law is amended in paragraph (b)
 - (a) by the deletion of the words "twenty-five pounds" and the substition therefor of the words "one thousand dollars"; and
 - (b) by the deletion of the words "three months" and the substitution therefor of the words "twelve months".
