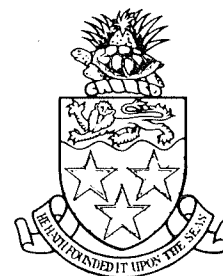

**A LAW TO AMEND THE INTERPRETATION LAW
(CAP. 70)**

ENACTED by the Legislature of the Cayman Islands.

Short title.

1. This Law may be cited as the Interpretation (Amendment) Law, 1987.

Insertion of new
s. 51A in Cap. 70.

2. The Interpretation Law is amended by inserting the following new section immediately after section 51 -

“Appointment
to statutory
public office.

51A. Notwithstanding the provisions of this or of any other law, where provision is made in a law for a public officer to be appointed to an office under that law which involves the exercise of functions, powers or duties pursuant to any law or regulations and where no such appointment of such person has been made under that law prior to the date when an appointment was made to such public office, the person appointed to such public office shall, for the purposes of any such law or regulations, be deemed to have been appointed under that law on the date
