**THE LIQUOR LICENSING (FEES) REGULATIONS, 1985**

In exercise of the powers conferred upon the Governor by section 43 of the Liquor Licensing Law, 1974 the following Regulations are hereby made -

Citation.

1. These regulation may be cited as the Liquor Licensing Law (Fees) Regulations, 1985.

Prescription of  
licence fees.

2. (1) Subject to the provisions of subsection (2), for the purposes of section 10(3) of the Liquor Licensing Law, 1974 (hereinafter called the “principal Law”) the following fees are prescribed for the issue of licences -

- (a) Distributors ..... \$2,400.00 per annum
- (b) Package ..... \$ 750.00 per annum
- (c) Retail ..... \$ 500.00 per annum
- (d) Hotel -  
  
where such hotel has twenty  
bedrooms or less ..... \$1,000.00 per annum  
  
where such hotel has more  
than twenty bedrooms ..... \$2,400.00 per annum
- (e) Temporary ..... \$ 500.00
- (f) Restaurant ..... \$ 750.00 per annum
- (g) Wine and Beer ..... \$ 500.00 per annum.

(2) Where any distributors, package, hotel or restaurant licence is issued in respect of premises situated in Cayman Brac or Little Cayman the fees for the issue of such licence shall be fifty per centum of the fee prescribed in sub-section (1).
