## A LAW TO AUTHORISE THE BORROWING OF UP TO CI\$16,160,000 FOR THE FINANCING OF SPECIFIED CAPITAL PROJECTS

ENACTED by the Legislature of the Cayman Islands.

Short title.

1. This Law may be cited as the Loan (Capital Projects) Law, 1995.

Power to borrow.

- 2. The amount referred to in subsection (1) may be borrowed:
  - (a) by installments; and
  - (b) from any person, and on such terms and conditions, as the Governor in Council may approve.

Appropriation of loan to specified purposes.

3. The money borrowed under section 2 shall be appropriated to one or more of the purposes specified in the first column of the Schedule, and applied to any such purpose in an amount not exceeding the amount specified in respect of that purpose in the second column of that Schedule.
