THE MARINE CONSERVATION LAW, 1978 [No. 19 of 1978]

THE MARINE CONSERVATION REGULATIONS, 1979

In the exercise of the powers conferred upon the Governor in Council by section 24 of the above Law, the following Regulations are hereby made.

Citation.

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Marine Conservation Regulations, 1979.

Interpretation.

2. In these Regulations —

"Law" means the Marine Conservation Law, 1978 and includes subordinate legislation made under it;

"section" means a section of the Law; and

section 2 applies.

Seizure, disposal, etc. of marine life caught in contravention of this Law.

- 3. A Fishery Inspector may, in any place in which under section 4(4) he may lawfully search any person, seize any marine life which he has reason to believe has been caught in the commission of an offence or which is possessed in contravention of this Law and he may in his discretion
 - (a) return such marine life to its natural habitat;
 - (b) retain it for production in evidence; or
 - (c) dispose of it in any manner he deems expedient:

Provided that if such disposal is effected by way of sale the net proceeds thereof shall be paid into the revenues of the Islands.

Badges and insignia, 4. The badges and insignia prescribed in the Schedule shall be worn and displayed by Fishery Inspectors whenever they are performing their duties as such.

Forms.

5. Letters of appointment of Fishery Inspectors and the forms to be used in the application for and granting of licences and authorization under the Law are prescribed in the Schedule.

Fees.

6. Fees to be charged in connection with licences and authorization under the Law are prescribed in the Schedule.

Penal.

7. Whoever resists or obstructs a Fishery Inspector in the discharge



THE SCHEDULE |Regulation 5|

The following are the prescribed insignia and badges for the purpose of regulation 5:-

- a) insignia or badge prescribed to be displayed or worn by game wardens under the Animals Law;
 b) flags of the dimensions and colour indicated below when displayed on any vessel or vehicle;
 c) badges of the dimensions and style described below when worn on dress or headgear.
