THE MARINE CONSERVATION LAW, 1978
THE MARINE CONSERVATION
[AMENDMENT] REGULATIONS, 1980

In exercise of the powers conferred upon the Governor in Council by section 24 of the Marine Conservation Law, 1978, the following Regulations are hereby made.

Citation.	1. These Regulations may be cited as the Marine Conservation (Amendment) Regulations, 1980.
Revocation and replacement of Regulation 4 of the Marine Conservation Regulations, 1979.	2. Regulation 4 of the Marine Conservation Regulations, 1979, (hereinafter referred to as the principal Regulations) is hereby revoked and the following new regulation substituted therefor – “Badges, insignia and Identification Cards. 4. (1) The badges and insignia prescribed in the Schedule shall be worn and displayed by Fishery Inspectors whenever they are performing their duties as such. The Schedule. (2) The Board shall issue to each Fishery Inspector an Identification Card in the form set out in the Schedule, which Card shall remain the property of the Board. Each Fishery Inspector shall carry his Identification Card with him whenever performing his duties as such and shall on reasonable demand being made by any person produce such Card for the inspection of that person.”.
Amendment of the Schedule to the principal Regulations.	3. The Schedule to the principal Regulations is hereby amended as follows – (a) by substituting for the figure 5 appearing in the first and third lines thereof the figure 4; (b) by deleting paragraph (c) appearing in the eighth and ninth lines thereof; (c) by deleting the word “Badge”, the badge and the words “3
