The Governor in Council, after consultation with the Secretary of State for Transport of the United Kingdom, in exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 78 of the Merchant Shipping (Applicable Conventions) Law 1987, and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby makes the following Order:

Citation and Commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the Merchant Shipping (Safety Provisions) (Application) Order 1988 and shall come into force on the day after it is made.

Interpretation

1 1 1

- 2. (1) In this Order "the applied legislation" means the subsidiary legislation specified in Schedule 1.
- (2) In this Order and in any part of the applied legislation where reference to "the Secretary of State" is to be construed as reference to "the Governor", "the Governor" means the Governor in Council.

 - (2) The exceptions, adaptations and modifications specified in Schedule 2 shall, where relevant, apply to all parts of the applied legislation except where such exceptions, adaptations and modifications are inconsistent with the provisions of any other Schedule in respect of a provision of the applied legislation.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Order)

This Order applies to the Cayman Islands, subject to the exceptions, adaptations and modifications specified in Schedules 2 to 10 of the Order, the United Kingdom Regulations listed in Schedule 1 of the Order (the "applied legislation") so as to implement in the Cayman Islands the provisions of the International Convention for the Safety of Life at Sea 1974 and the Protocol of 1978 relating thereto.

Under the terms of Schedule 11 of the Order, the applied legislation will come into operation in respect of all ships on 1st May 1988 subject to the provision of interim arrangements for ships registered in the Cayman Islands on or before 30th April 1988. The interim arrangement for ships registered in the Cayman Islands on or before 30th April 1988 are that

- (1) no offence is committed if such a ship fails to comply with the requirements of the provisions of the applied legislation before 1st August 1989 unless
 - (a) the ship, being a passenger ship, has been issued with a passenger ship safety construction certificate, in which case failure to comply with such requirements will be an offence after the issue of such certificate;
 - (b) the ship, not being a passenger ship, has been issued with a cargo ship safety construction certificate or a safety equipment certificate or a radio certificate, in which case failure to comply with such requirements will be an offence after the issue of any such certificate;
 - (c) the ship has undergone a load line survey between 1st August 1987 and 30th April 1988, in which case failure

- (5) Without prejudice to sub-paragraphs (2) and (3) of this paragraph, where any ship registered in the Cayman Islands on or before 30th April 1988 has undergone a load line survey in the period from 1st May 1987 to 31st July 1987 (inclusive), the owner and the master of such ship (as the case may be) shall be guilty of any offence specified in any provision of the applied legislation in respect of any failure to comply with the requirements of any provision of the applied legislation after the second anniversary date.
- 4. No ship registered in the Cayman Islands on or before 30th April 1988 in respect of which the owner and master are not guilty of an offence for failing to comply with the requirements of any provision of the applied legislation shall be liable to be detained under any provision of the applied legislation unless the Chief Marine Surveyor has reasonable cause for believing that if such ship proceeded to sea there would be serious danger to human life.

Interpretation

1. In this Schedule the following expressions shall have the following meanings:

"anniversary date" means the date falling at the expiry of one year from the completion of the load line survey referred to in sub-paragraphs (4) and (5) of paragraph 3 of this Schedule;

"Chief Marine Surveyor" means the Chief Marine Surveyor appointed by the Governor under the Merchant Shipping (Applicable Conventions) Law 1987 or any person appointed by the Chief Marine Surveyor to act on his behalf;

"load line survey" means any survey undergone by a ship for the purpose of determining, or involving the determination of, whether such ship complies with the conditions of assignment of the load lines applicable to it;

"second anniversary date" means the date falling at the expiry of two years from the completion of the load line survey referred to in sub-paragraphs (4) and (5) of paragraph 3 of this Schedule.

Commencement of the applied legislation

- 2. Subject to the provisions of paragraphs 3 and 4 of this Schedule, the applied legislation shall come into operation on 1st May 1988.
- 3. (1) Without prejudice to any power which is now or may hereafter be vested in the Governor or the Chief Marine Surveyor to remove a ship from the Register of Ships in the Cayman Islands and subject to sub-paragraphs (2), (3), (4) and (5) of this paragraph, neither the owner nor the master of any ship registered in the Cayman Islands on or before 30th April 1988 which fails to comply with the requirements
