A LAW TO AMEND THE MUSIC AND DANCING (CONTROL) LAW, 1977

ENACTED by the Legislature of the Cayman Islands.

Short title.

1. This Law may be cited as the Music and Dancing (Control) (Amendment) Law, 1989.

Amendment of s.2

2. Section 2 of the Music and Dancing (Control) Law, 1977, in this Law referred to as the principal Law, is amended by deletion of the definition of "permitted days" and substitution of the following new definition therefor-"

"permitted days" means such days as are prescribed as such by the Board in accordance with subsection (1) of section 9:".
