## A LAW TO AMEND THE MUSIC AND DANCING (CONTROL) LAW, 1977, TO ALLOW RESTAURANTS AND HOTELS TO PLAY SOFT BACKGROUND MUSIC ON RESTRICTED DAYS

Short title.

1. This Law may be cited as the Music and Dancing (Control)(Amendment) Law, 1991.

Amendment of sec. 3 of Law 10 of 1977.

- 2. Section 3 of the Music and Dancing (Control) Law, 1977, is amended by --
  - (a) renumbering the section as subsection (1);
  - b) adding the following as subsection (2) -
    - "(2) Notwithstanding subsection (1)(b) music may be played on Sunday, Good Friday and Christmas Day in a restaurant or hotel, being premises subject to this Law, provided the following conditions are observed
      - the music must be pre-recorded music of a soft, background nature, not to be heard beyond the boundaries of the property on which it is played;
      - (b) the time during which it is played shall be between
