

| Short title.                           | 1. This Law may be cited as the Music and Dancing (Control)(Amendment) Law, 1991.  |
| Amendment of sec. 3 of Law 10 of 1977. | 2. Section 3 of the Music and Dancing (Control) Law, 1977, is amended by –<br><br>(a) renumbering the section as subsection (1);<br><br>(b) adding the following as subsection (2) –<br><br>“(2) Notwithstanding subsection (1)(b) music may be played on Sunday, Good Friday and Christmas Day in a restaurant or hotel, being premises subject to this Law, provided the following conditions are observed –<br><br>(a) the music must be pre-recorded music of a soft, background nature, not to be heard beyond the boundaries of the property on which it is played;<br><br>(b) the time during which it is played shall be between |
