**A LAW TO AMEND THE NATIONAL PENSIONS LAW (1998  
REVISION) TO INTRODUCE MAXIMUM CONTRIBUTIONS FOR  
EMPLOYEES AND TO WIDEN THE DEFINITION OF SELF-  
EMPLOYED PERSONS WHO ARE REQUIRED TO CONTRIBUTE TO A  
PENSION PLAN**

ENACTED by the Legislature of the Cayman Islands.

1. This Law may be cited as the National Pensions (Amendment) (Self Employed Persons and Prescribed Maximum) Law, 1999.

Short title
2. In this Law, unless the context requires otherwise “the principal Law” means the National Pensions Law (1998 Revision).

Definition
3. Section 3 of the principal Law is amended in the definition of “self-employed person” by repealing the words “and who possesses a current licence under the Trade and Business Licensing Law (1996 Revision)”.
