 - "(c) insures such person, persons or classes of persons, as may be specified in the policy in respect of any liability which may be incurred by him or them in respect of the damage to any property caused by, or arising out of, the use of the motor vehicle on a road; and
 - (d) covers liability -
 - (i) of not less than one million dollars in respect of the death of, or bodily injury to, any person; and
 - (ii) of not less than five million dollars in the aggregate in any one event:"; and
- (d) in paragraph (iv) of the proviso, by repealing the words "one hundred thousand dollars" and substituting the words "two hundred and fifty thousand dollars".
