THE AIR NAVIGATION (FEES) (AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS, 1991

In exercise of the powers conferred upon the Governor by Article 98 of the Air Navigation (Overseas Territories) Order, 1989, the following Regulations are made —

Citation and commencement.

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Air Navigation (Fees) (Amendment) Regulations, 1991, and shall be deemed to have come into force on the first day of December, 1990.

Amendment of the Air Navigation (Fees) Regulations. 2. The Air Navigation (Fees) Regulations, 1990, are amended by inserting next after regulation 23, the following as regulation 23A.

Air Operator's Certificate.

23A. (1) When an application is made for the granting of an Air Operator's Certificate under Article 6 of the Air Navigation (Overseas Territories) Order, 1989, the applicant shall pay a charge based on the maximum all-up weight of the aircraft as shown in the Certificate of Airworthiness in accordance with the following table —

Maximum A.U.W.	Charge	
Aircraft –		
Not exceeding 5,700 kg.	\$200.00	
Exceeding 5,700 kg but not exceeding 34,000 kg.	\$400.00	

Exceeding 34,000 but not exceeding 91,000 kg.

\$800.00

Exceeding 91,000 kg.

\$1,000.00

(2) An annual charge shall be made on the operator to cover the cost of monitoring the operation of the airline as may be necessary to meet the conditions of the Air Operator's Certificate.".
