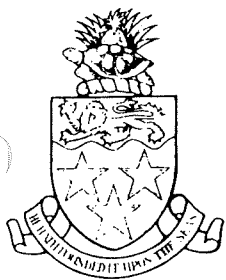

**A LAW TO AMEND THE AIRPORTS
REGULATION LAW (REVISED).**

ENACTED by the Legislature of the Cayman Islands.

Short title.

1. This Law may be cited as the Airports Regulation (Amendment) Law, 1984.

Insertion of new
section 4A.

2. The Airports Regulation Law (Revised) is amended by inserting the following new section immediately after section 4 —

“Arrest. 4A. Notwithstanding any other provision of this Law, a constable or any person authorised in that behalf in writing by the Governor may, within any area designated an airport, arrest without warrant —

- (a) any person contravening or suspected of having contravened any provision of this Law or of any regulations made hereunder;
- (b) any person who, having been so requested under section 4, fails or refuses to correctly state his name and address or the purpose of his being at the airport;
- (c) any person who, having been removed from an airport or any part thereof, under section 4, returns or attempts to return thereto without the approval of a constable or a person so authorised:

Provided that any person arrested under this section by a person so authorised shall as soon as practicable be handed

over by him to a constable or taken by him to a police station.”.
