

MEMORANDUM OF OBJECTS AND REASONS

The definition of "biological product" in section 2 of the Law is insufficiently wide to enable the C.A.V.O. to exercise the control over imports considered necessary and it is sought to remedy this defect. It is also desired to render the C.A.V.O. in some measure subject to directions from the Governor in Council and to repeal the Animals Importation Law.

A LAW to amend the Animals Law (Law 8 of 1976).

ENACTED by the Legislature of the Cayman Islands.

Short title.

1. This Law may be cited as the Animals (Amendment) Law, 1977.

Law 8 of 1976 amended

- 2. The Animals Law is hereby amended as follows
 - (a) in section 2 by inserting between the words "and" and "used" occurring in the second line of the definition of "biological product" the words "includes substances";
 - (b) in section 82 by the addition of a new paragraph to follow paragraph "(h)" as follows —

"Cap. 4

- (i) The Animals Importation Law.";
- (c) by the addition of a new section as follows -

"C.A.V.O. is subject

84. In carrying out his duties under this Law the C.A.V O. is subject to the directions of the Governor in Council.".
