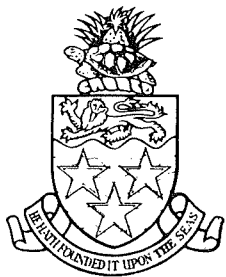

A LAW TO AMEND THE ANIMALS LAW

ENACTED by the Legislature of the Cayman Islands.

Citation.

1. This Law may be cited as the Animals (Amendment) Law, 1990.

Amendment to s.57 of
Law 8 of 1976.

2. The Animals Law is hereby amended by addition of the following new section immediately after section 57 -

"57A. (1) The Governor in Council may, by Order, prohibit the riding or driving of any animal in any public place either absolutely or at such times or subject to such conditions as are specified in the Order.

(2) Any person who contravenes an Order made under this section shall be guilty of an offence and liable on summary conviction to a fine not exceeding \$500 or to a term of imprisonment not exceeding six months or both."

Passed by the Legislative Assembly this 20th day of February, 1990.
