# THE ANIMALS (CONTROL) REGULATIONS

In exercise of the powers conferred upon the Governor in Council by sections 57 and 80 of the above Law the following Regulations are hereby made.

Citation.

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Animals (Control) Regulations.

Interpretation.

2. In these Regulations —

"airfield" means an airfield listed in the Schedule;

"Law" means the Animals Law (Law 8 of 1976);

"section" means a section of this Law; and section 2 applies.

Establishment of pounds and pound-keepers.

3. The places and persons set forth in the Schedule are established as pounds and appointed as poundkeepers respectively for the purpose of section 43.

Fees for service of notice of animals impounded.

4. The fees prescribed for the purpose of section 44 are as follows —

(a) cattle and horses

\$3 per head

(b) other animals

\$1 per head

Fees for maintenance of impounded animals. 5. The daily maintenance fees for impounded animals for the purpose of section 46 are -

(a) cattle and horses

\$2 per head

(b) other animals

\$1 per head

Poundkeepers remuneration.

- 6. For the purpose of section 49, poundkeepers are entitled to retain one half of all fees collected by them under Regulation 4 and the whole of all fees collected under Regulation 5.
- 7. (1) For the purpose of section 51 the seizure fees are as follows
  - (i) for animals seized on an airfield under the authority or by direction of the Director of Civil Aviation
    - (a) cattle and horses

\$10 per head per day;

(b) other animals

\$ 2 per head per day;

- (ii) for animals seized elsewhere than on airfields -
  - (a) cattle and horses

\$2 per head per day

(b) other animals

\$1 per head per day;

(2) Fees collected by or on behalf of the Director of Civil Aviation shall be accounted for to the Treasury.

## THE SCHEDULE (Regulation 2)

The following are prescribed airfields—

- The airport of Grand Cayman.
  The airport of Cayman Brac.
  The airfield of Little Cayman.

## (Regulation 3)

The following are prescribed pounds -

- 1. The Agricultural Nursery on the airport land at Smith Road, Grand Cayman.

  - The Agricultural Farm at Lower Valley.
    In any area South of the runway at Cayman Brac Airport.
  - 4. The District Office area at Little Cayman

The following are prescribed poundkeepers.

The Chief Agricultural and Veterinary Officer

The Chief Airport Fire Officer

The Supervisor, Public Works Cayman Brac

The District Officer, Little Cayman.
