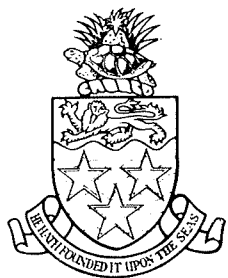

**THE ANIMALS LAW
(LAW 8 OF 1976)
THE ANIMALS (PROTECTION) REGULATIONS, 1989**

In exercise of the powers conferred upon the Governor in Council by section 74 of the Animals Law, 1976, the following Regulations are hereby made -

Citation. 1. These Regulations may be cited as the Animals (Protection) Regulations, 1989.

Alteration to list of Game Birds. 2. The list of game birds contained in section 69 of the Animals Law is hereby altered by deletion of that list and substitution of the following new list therefore -

White-Winged dove (white wing)
(Zenaida asiatica)

White-Crowned Pigeon (bald pate)
(Columba leucocephala)

Blue-Winged Teal
(Anas discors).

Close Season. 3. The period from 1st day of February to the 31st day of July inclusive in each year is hereby prescribed as a Close Season.

Limitation on number of game birds which may be taken. 4. The limit on the number of game birds which may be taken by one person on any one day is as follows -

(a) twelve White-Winged Doves; twelve White-Crowned Pigeons or any combination thereof;

PROVIDED THAT the number of birds taken shall not exceed 12; and

(b) three Blue-Winged Teal.
