THE ANIMALS LAW (LAW 8 OF 1976)

THE ANIMALS (RESTRICTIONS ON RIDING) ORDER, 1990

In exercise of the powers conferred upon the Governor in Council by section 57A of the Animals Law, the following Order is hereby made -

- Citation. 1. This Order may be cited as the Animals (Restrictions on Riding) Order, 1990.
- Interpretation. 2. For the purposes of this Order the following definitions shall apply -
- (a) "Beach" means the seashore and seabed (irrespective of its physical constituents) lying on the seaward side of whichever of the building, vegetation or fence line is closest to the seawater at any given point;
 - (b) "Seven Mile Beach" includes all that area of beach which is located at the southern extremity from a line due west of the Wharf Restaurant at latitude North 19° 18' 26" and longitude west 81° 23' 08" and on the northern extremity a line due west of the junction of West Bay Road/Town Hall Road/Northwest Point Road at: latitude North 19° 22' 26" and longitude West 81° 24' 16"; and
 - (c) "Night" means any time between sunset and the following sunrise.

Restrictions on riding
on Seven Mile Beach.

3. The following restrictions shall apply to the riding and driving of horses on Seven Mile Beach:

- (a) The riding or driving of any horse on that part of Seven Mile Beach known as "the Public Beach" and being part of Block 11B Parcel 8, is prohibited at all times.
- (b) The riding or driving of horses on any other part of the Seven Mile Beach is permitted, except for the hours between 9 a.m. and 5 p.m. on Saturdays, Sundays and Public Holidays, when it is prohibited.
- (c) Any person riding a horse on Seven Mile Beach shall control his mount so as not to approach any other person closely enough to cause him unreasonable fear or alarm.

Prohibition on riding
at night.

4. The riding of horses on any road or beach or in any other public place at night is prohibited.
