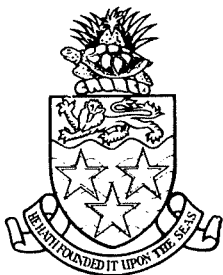

**A LAW TO APPROPRIATE CERTAIN  
EXPENDITURES FOR THE SERVICES OF  
THE FINANCIAL YEAR 1990**

ENACTED by the Legislature of the Cayman Islands.

Short title.

1. This Law may be cited as the Appropriation (1990) Law, 1989.

Expenditure of  
\$104,122,262.

2. The Financial Secretary of the Islands may pay a sum not exceeding in the aggregate one hundred and four million, one hundred and twenty-two thousand, two hundred and sixty-two dollars for defraying the several charges and expenses of the Government of the Islands and for other purposes for the period 1st January, 1990 to 31st December, 1990 as set forth in the Schedule to this Law and such sum is hereby charged upon the revenue and funds of the Islands.
