A LAW TO AMEND THE APPROPRIATION LAW, 1989

ENACTED by the Legislature of the Cayman Islands.

Short title.

- 1. This Law may be cited as the Appropriation (Amendment) Law, 1989.
- Amendment of s.2.
- 2. Section 2 of the Appropriation Law, 1989, in this Law referred to as the principal Law, is amended by deleting section 2 and substituting the following -

"Expenditure of \$96,908,042

2. The Financial Secretary of the Cayman Islands may pay a sum not exceeding in the aggregate ninety six million, nine hundred and eight thousand, and forty two dollars for defraying the several charges and expenses of the Government of the Islands and for other purposes for the period 1st January, 1989, to 31st December, 1989, as set forth in the Schedule to

this Law and such sum is hereby charged upon the revenue and funds of the Islands."

Passed the Legislative Assembly this 21st day of November, 1989.
