### THE BANKS AND TRUST COMPANIES (LICENCE APPLICATIONS AND FEES) (AMENDMENT) (NO. 2) REGULATIONS, 2006

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 23 of the Banks and Trust Companies Law (2003 Revision), the Governor in Cabinet makes the following regulations -

1. These regulations may be cited as the Banks and Trust Companies (Licence <sup>Citation</sup> Applications and Fees) (Amendment) (No. 2) Regulations, 2006.

2. The Banks and Trust Companies (Licence Applications and Fees) Regulations (2003 Revision) are amended by inserting after regulation 6 the following regulation -

Insertion of regulation 6A in the Banks and Trust Companies (Licence Applications and Fees) Regulations (2003 Revision) - fees payable for registration of controlled subsidiary
