A LAW PROVIDING FOR THE DECLARATION OF THE CAYMAN ISLANDS NATIONAL HEROES

ENACTED by the Legislature of the Cayman Islands.

1. This Law may be cited as the Cayman Islands National Heroes Law, 1993.
2. Except in section 5, in this Law "Governor" means the Governor in Council.
3. (1) The Governor may, by proclamation published in the Gazette, declare a man or a woman he considers to have provided exceptional and outstanding service to the Cayman Islands and the peoples of the Cayman Islands to be a Cayman Islands National Hero.
(2) A man or woman may be proclaimed to be a Cayman Islands

circumstances to withdraw the recognition of the person as a Cayman Islands National Hero.

7. (1) A person must not accept or obtain or agree to accept or attempt to obtain from any person, for himself or for any other person or for any purpose any gift, money or valuable consideration as an inducement or reward for procuring or assisting or endeavouring to procure the grant of an honour under this Law.

Penalty: Fine not exceeding \$5,000

(2) A person must not give or agree or propose to give, or offer to any person any gift, money or valuable consideration as an inducement or reward for procuring or assisting or endeavouring to procure the grant of an honour under this Law to any person.

Penalty: Fine not exceeding \$5,000

(3) A person carrying on, or attempting to carry on business on or from the island must not in the course of his or her activities in connection with that business take any action or do anything that is likely to suggest, falsely-

(a) the patronage of or connection with a Cayman Islands National Hero, or

(b) that the business has a special status in relation to or derived from a Cayman Islands National Hero.

Penalty: Fine not exceeding \$5,000

(4) Nothing in subsection (1) and (2) prohibits the Governor from seeking nominations of people to be declared Cayman Islands National Heroes or people from making nominations or recommendations to the Governor in respect of people to be declared Cayman Islands National Heroes.

Governor to
bestow award.

5. The Governor may, in person, honour a Cayman Islands National Hero or the memory of a Cayman Islands National Hero at a public ceremony where the Governor shall bestow upon the National Hero or a person appearing on behalf of the National Hero an award or other recognition of the National Hero's service to the Cayman Islands and the peoples of the Cayman Islands.

Revocation of
Declaration.

6. (1) The Governor may for good reason revoke, by proclamation published in the Gazette, the declaration of a person as a Cayman Islands National Hero.

(2) Where a proclamation is made under subsection (1) the Governor may take such other action as is appropriate in the
