THE CAYMANIAN PROTECTION (AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS, 1990

In exercise of the powers conferred upon the Governor by section 71 of the Caymanian Protection Law, 1984, the following regulations are hereby made:

- Citation. 1. These regulations may be cited as the Caymanian Protection (Amendment) Regulations, 1990.
- Amendment of Second Schedule. 2. The Second Schedule to the Caymanian Protection Regulations, 1985 is replaced by the following --

Grant of Gainful Occupation Licence --

- (a) Ministers of religion, Nurses, Teachers (including Nursery School Teachers) and persons working for a non-profit, cultural, or charitable entity Nil
- (b) Domestic, manual, and unskilled workers 100.00
- (c) Workers in agriculture (other than manual or unskilled workers) 300.00
- (d) (i) Secretarial personnel 700.00
(ii) Executive Secretaries 1,000.00
- (e) Clerical personnel (including Sales Clerks) 400.00
- (f) Skilled Tradesmen 1,000.00
- (g) Administrative personnel (including non-professional supervisory staff) and others occupying positions for which qualifications acquired at or through an institution for technical training are required and including Real Estate Salespersons 1,500.00
- (h) Deputy or Assistant non-professional Managerial Personnel 2,000.00
- (i) Chief Executive Officers and Managing Directors 4,000.00
- (j) Professional Managers and other personnel occupying positions for which qualifications are acquired at or through an institution for professional training (e.g. Chartered Accountants, Bankers, Surveyors, Architects, Doctors, Engineers, et al.) 3,000.00

(ii) if any such licence ceases to be effective (for whatever cause) before the end of the period for which it was granted, a refund of one-half of the annual fee shall be made for that part (not being less than six months) of the period after the licence ceased to be effective.

- (a) Application for permanent residence 50.00
- (b) Grant of Certificate of permanent residence 400.00
- Temporary Gainful Occupation Licence (for period not exceeding 30 days) -
 - (a) Managerial and Professional Workers 150.00
 - (b) Skilled and Technical Workers 75.00
 - (c) Ministers of religion, Nurses, Teachers (including Nursery School Teachers) and persons working for a non-profit, cultural, or charitable entity Nil
 - (d) Others 50.00
 - (e) Extensions of Temporary Gainful Occupation Licences for each period of 7 days or part thereof 15.00
- Issue of Re-entry Permit 15.00

3. These Regulations shall come into force on the 1st day of August, 1990.
