THE CENSUS (CAYMAN BRAC) ORDER, 1987

In exercise of the powers conferred on the Governor in Council by section 4 of the Statistics Law, 1970, the following Order is hereby made -

| Citation.                         | 1. This Order may be cited as the Census (Cayman Brac) Order, 1987.   |
| Interpretation.                   | 2. In this Order, unless the context otherwise requires,<br>“census day” means the 29th day of June, 1987;<br>“census night” means the period of from 9.00 p.m. on census day to 6.00 a.m. on the following day, or a part of such period;<br>“head of household” means that person in the household who is acknowledged as such by the other members;<br>“resident” means having a usual residence in Cayman Brac for at least six month after the date of last arrival. |
| Requirement to take census.       | 3. A census shall be taken of the population of Cayman Brac as at census day.   |
| Persons to be included in census. | 4. Returns for the purposes of the census shall be made with respect to all resident person who are alive at midnight on census night, and -<br><div style="margin-left: 40px;">(a) who pass census night on land within Cayman Brac; or<br/>(b) who, being resident, are absent from Cayman Brac on census night with the intention to return not later than six months after the date of leaving.</div>   |
| Persons by whom returns made.     | 5. Subject to paragraphs (b) and (c) of regulation 9 of the Census (Cayman Brac) Regulations, 1987, the returns shall be made by the head of household.   |

6. The particulars to be stated in the returns in respect of every  
resident shall be -

Name

Sex

Date of birth

Relationship to head of household

Nationality

Whether the greater part of the time of  
the resident is spent outside Cayman Brac.
