

A LAW to amend the Cinematograph Law (Cap. 18). ENACTED by the Legislature of the Cayman Islands.

Short title.

1. This Law may be cited as the Cinematograph (Amendment) Law,

Amendment of section 9 of the Cinematograph Law (Cap. 18). 2. Section 9 of the Cinematograph Law is hereby amended by deleting the words "twenty pounds or to imprisonment for a term not exceeding three months" and substituting therefor the words "two thousand dollars or to imprisonment for a period not exceeding twelve months or both".

Passed the Legislative Assembly this 6th day of September, 1979.
