A LAW TO AMEND THE COAT OF ARMS, FLAG AND NATIONAL SONG LAW (2004 REVISION); TO REVISE THE LAW RELATING TO THE USE OF THE COAT OF ARMS AND FLAG OF THE ISLANDS IN POLITICAL CAMPAIGNS

Enacted by the Legislature of the Cayman Islands.

- 1. This Law may be cited as the Coat of Arms, Flag and National Song (Amendment) Law, 2004.
- Short title
- 2. The Coat of Arms, Flag and National Song Law (2004 Revision) is amended in section 2 as follows -
 - (a) in subsection (1) by repealing the words "Subject to subsection (2)" and substituting the words "Subject to the other provisions of this section"; and
 - (b) by inserting after subsection (2) the following subsections -
 - "(3) Subsection (1) does not apply to the use by a person of -
 - (a) any advertisement, circular or publication (whether transmitted by electronic means or otherwise);
 - (b) any article of clothing; or

Amendment of section 2 of the Coat of Arms, Flag and National Song Law (2004 Revision) - unauthorised use of Coat of Arms or flag an offence

(c) any other item,

that contains the Coat of Arms or flag of the Islands, where such use is with a view to promoting or procuring the election of a candidate at an election.

(4) In this section -

"candidate" means a person who intends to seek nomination, or who has been nominated, as a candidate to contest an election; and

"election" means an election of a member or members to the Legislative Assembly.".
