

(c) by inserting in the appropriate alphabetical placing the following:

' "Vice President" means a Vice President of the College appointed by the Board under section 17.'

Amendment of section 3 - Establishment of College

4. The principal Law is amended in section 3 as follows -

- (a) in subsection (1), by repealing the words "Community College" and substituting the words "University College";
- (b) in subsection (3),
  - (i) paragraph (c), by repealing the words "four members" and substituting the words "six members";
  - (ii) paragraph (e), by repealing the words "shall be a Dean" and substituting the words "shall be from the College Faculty";
- (d) in subsection (11), by repealing the words "Five members" and substituting the words "Six members";
- (e) in subsection (15),
  - (i) by repealing the words "this Law" and substituting the words "this Law and any regulations made under it";
  - (ii) by repealing the words "in all respects".

Amendment of section 4 - functions of College

5. The principal Law is amended in section 4 (1) by repealing the words "post-secondary" and substituting the words "tertiary".

Repeal and substitution of section 9 - Liability of members

6. The principal Law is amended by the repeal of section 9 and the substituting the following -

"Liability of members

9. Neither the College nor any member of the Board or employee of the College shall be liable in damages for anything done or omitted in the discharge of their respective functions under this Law unless it is shown that the act or omission was in bad faith."

Amendment of section 13 - Powers of Board

7. The principal Law is amended in section 13 (1) (f) by repealing the words "to award" and substituting the words "to award degrees,".

8. The principal Law is amended by the repeal of section 17 and substituting the following -

" Vice Presidents

17. The Board may appoint up to two Vice Presidents, one of whom shall be designated to act for the President when the President is away, and who shall perform such other duties as may be assigned to him by the Board or the President. "

Repeal and substitution of section 17 - Vice Presidents

9. The principal Law is amended in paragraph 1 of the Schedule-

(a) by repealing subparagraph (b) and substituting the following-

"(b) the Vice President or Vice Presidents appointed under section 17;

(b) by repealing subparagraph (f) and substituting the following-

"(f) a Faculty member elected by the Faculty;"

**A LAW TO AMEND THE COMMUNITY COLLEGE LAW (1999  
REVISION) TO EMPOWER THE INSTITUTION TO AWARD  
BACHELORS DEGREES; AND TO MAKE PROVISION FOR RELATED  
MATTERS**

ENACTED by the Legislature of the Cayman Islands.

1. (1) This Law may be cited as the Community College (Amendment) Law, 2004. Short title and commencement

(2) This Law shall come into operation on 1<sup>st</sup> August, 2004.

2. The Community College Law (1999 Revision), in this Law referred to as the "principal Law", is amended in section 1 by deleting the words "Community College Law" and substituting the words "University College Law". Amendment of section 1 - short title

3. The principal Law is amended in section 2 as follows - Amendment of section 2 - definitions

(a) in the definition of "College", by repealing the words "Community College" and substituting the words "University College".

(b) at the end of the definition of "President" by repealing the word "and";
