**THE COMPANIES
(AMENDMENT) LAW, 1980
(Law 6 of 1980)**

ENACTED by the Legislature of the Cayman Islands

That Law may be cited as the Companies (Amendment) Law, 1980.

1. Section 2 of the Companies Law is hereby amended by adding, in alphabetical sequence, the following new definition -
"international company" means the meaning ascribed to that term in section 2(1) of the Legal Companies (Control) Law (Law 10 of 1978).

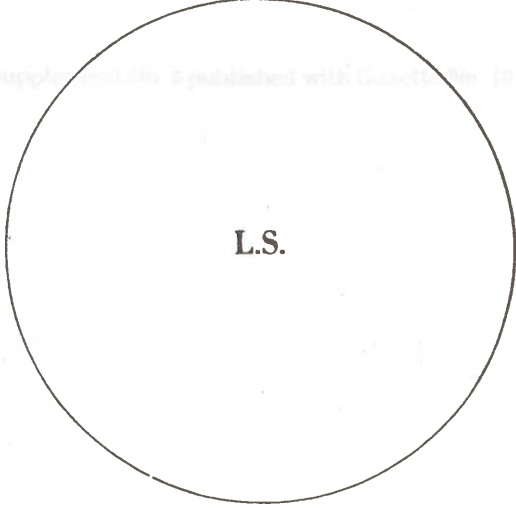

A LAW to amend the Companies Law (Cap. 22)

ENACTED by the Legislature of the Cayman Islands.

Short title

1. This Law may be cited as the Companies (Amendment) Law, 1980.

Amendment of
section 2 of the

Local Companies
(Control) Law (R).

2. Section 2 of the Companies Law is hereby amended by adding, in its appropriate alphabetical sequence, the following new definition -

“non-resident company” bears the meaning ascribed to that term in section 2 (1) of the Local Companies (Control) Law (Revised);”.
