A LAW TO AMEND THE COMPANIES LAW (CHAPTER 22)

ENACTED by the Legislature of the Cayman Islands.

- 1. This Law may be cited as the Companies (Amendment) Law, 1983 and shall come into force on the 1st day of January, 1984.
- 2. Section 26 of the Companies Law, in this Law referred to as the principal Law, is amended by inserting "(subject to section 30A)" immediately after "power" in the eighth line of subsection (2).
- 3. The principal Law is amended by inserting the following new section immediately after section 30-
 - "30A. (1) A company which is empowered by its articles of association to issue bearer shares, certificates or coupons has no power to hold land.
 - (2) The Registrar shall forthwith and without notice strike off the register a company which is in breach of subsection (1), and thereupon —
 - (a) the company shall be dissolved; and
 - (b) mutatis mutandis the provisions of Part VI shall apply.".
