A LAW TO AMEND THE COMPANIES LAW (CHAPTER 22)

ENACTED by the Legislature of the Cayman Islands.

Short title

1. This Law may be cited as the Companies (Amendment) (No. 2) Law, 1984.

Amendment of \$30A

2. Section 30A of the Companies Law, in this Law referred to as the principal Law, is amended by substituting a colon for the fullstop at the end of subsection (1) and by adding the following proviso -

"PROVIDED that the Financial Secretary may at his discretion, in the case of an exempt company so empowered that has never issued bearer shares, certificates or coupons, exempt that company in writing from the provisions of subsection (1) for so long as it does not issue bearer shares, certificates or coupons.".

Amendment of - 128

3. Section 128 of the principal Law is amended by deleting ", Jamaica," in the third line of subsection (2).
