In exercise of the powers conferred by section 34 of the Public Health Act (2021 Revision), the Cabinet makes the following Regulations —

**Citation**

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Control and Management of Covid-19 (Amendment) Regulations, 2021.

**Insertion of regulation 5A in the Control and Management of Covid-19 Regulations, 2021 - restaurants and bars**

2. The *Control and Management of Covid-19 Regulations, 2021* are amended by inserting after regulation 5 the following regulation —

**“Restaurants and bars**

- 5A.** (1) Restaurants and bars may offer indoor and outdoor services, subject to the owner or operator satisfying the following conditions —
- (a) each table shall be at least six feet apart; and
  - (b) servers and front of house staff shall wear masks or cloth face coverings while serving customers.

- (2) Notwithstanding the social distancing requirements under regulation 5, a person may be seated at a table in a restaurant or bar with another person who does not reside at the person's household.
- (3) An owner or operator of a restaurant or bar who contravenes paragraph (1) commits an offence and is liable on summary conviction to a fine of ten thousand dollars or to imprisonment for a term of two years, or to both."
