In exercise of the powers conferred by section 34 of the Public Health Act (2021 Revision), the Cabinet makes the following Regulations —

Citation

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Control of Covid-19 (Travel) (Amendment) (No. 3) Regulations, 2021.

Amendment of regulation 2 of the Control of Covid-19 (Travel) Regulations, 2021 - definitions

2. The *Control of Covid-19 (Travel) Regulations, 2021* are amended in regulation 2 as follows —
 - (a) by inserting after the definition of the words “**Customs and Border Control Service**” the following definition —

“**direct airside transit visa**” means a visa which permits the holder to pass through transit channels subject to the conditions that the holder —

 - (a) remain airside of the airport; and

- (b) depart from the same airport within twenty-four hours of arrival at that airport;”;
- (b) by deleting the definition of the words “**listed country**”; and
- (c) by repealing paragraph (4) and substituting the following paragraphs —
 - “(4) For the purpose of the definition of the words “**direct airside transit visa**”, “**airside**” means any part of the airport that is inaccessible to the general public but that is accessible to international arriving or international transiting passengers.
 - (5) For the purposes of these Regulations, a reference to “**departure**” or “**departure of the person’s flight to the Islands**” includes the departure of any connecting flights or transit flights for the purposes of the journey to the Islands, where —
 - (a) the duration of the layover between those flights is no more than twelve hours; or
 - (b) notwithstanding subparagraph (a) —
 - (i) the duration of the layover between those flights is no more than twenty-four hours; and
 - (ii) the relevant person is the holder of a direct airside transit visa issued by the relevant jurisdiction.”.

Repeal of regulation 7A of the Control of Covid-19 (Travel) Regulations, 2021 - requirements for persons after visit to a listed country or contact with person from a listed country

3. The principal Regulations are amended by repealing regulation 7A.
