# CONTROL OF COVID-19 (TRAVEL) (AMENDMENT) (NO. 3) REGULATIONS, 2021

(SL 88 of 2021)

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 34 of the Public Health Act (2021 Revision), the Cabinet makes the following Regulations —

#### Citation

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Control of Covid-19 (Travel) (Amendment) (No. 3) Regulations, 2021.

## Amendment of regulation 2 of the Control of Covid-19 (Travel) Regulations, 2021 - definitions

- **2.** The *Control of Covid-19 (Travel) Regulations, 2021* are amended in regulation 2 as follows
  - (a) by inserting after the definition of the words "Customs and Border Control Service" the following definition
    - ""direct airside transit visa" means a visa which permits the holder to pass through transit channels subject to the conditions that the holder —
    - (a) remain airside of the airport; and

- (b) depart from the same airport within twenty-four hours of arrival at that airport;";
- (b) by deleting the definition of the words "listed country"; and
- (c) by repealing paragraph (4) and substituting the following paragraphs
  - "(4) For the purpose of the definition of the words "direct airside transit visa", "airside" means any part of the airport that is inaccessible to the general public but that is accessible to international arriving or international transiting passengers.
  - (5) For the purposes of these Regulations, a reference to "departure" or "departure of the person's flight to the Islands" includes the departure of any connecting flights or transit flights for the purposes of the journey to the Islands, where
    - (a) the duration of the layover between those flights is no more than twelve hours; or
    - (b) notwithstanding subparagraph (a)
      - (i) the duration of the layover between those flights is no more than twenty-four hours; and
      - (ii) the relevant person is the holder of a direct airside transit visa issued by the relevant jurisdiction.".

Repeal of regulation 7A of the Control of Covid-19 (Travel) Regulations, 2021 - requirements for persons after visit to a listed country or contact with person from a listed country

3. The principal Regulations are amended by repealing regulation 7A.
