CORONER'S LAW, 1975 (NO. 15 OF 1975) CORONER'S COURT (EVIDENCE) (AMENDMENT) RULES, 1983

Pursuant to section 24 of the above Law the following Rules are hereby made.

Citation.

1. These Rules may be cited as the Coroner's Court (Evidence) (Amendment) Rules, 1983.

Amendment of R.3 of the principal Rules.

- 2. Rule 3 of the Coroner's Court (Evidence) Rules, 1979 is amended
 - (i) by the deletion of the word "and" immediately following paragraph (b) thereof;
 - (ii) by the deletion of the fullstop immediately following paragraph (c) and the substitution therefor of a semicolon and the word "and"; and
 - (iii) by the addition, immediately following the said amended paragraph (c) of the following new paragraph
 - "(d) (i) shall allow any person who in the Coroner's opinion is a properly interested person to examine any witness at an inquest either in person or by an attorney-at-law;
 - (ii) shall allow the Attorney-General or any attorney-at-law nominated by the Attorney-General for the purpose to examine any witness at an inquest in which the Crown or any department in Government is interested:

Provided nevertheless that the Coroner shall disallow any

question or answer which in his opinion is not relevant or is otherwise not a proper question or answer.".
