THE CUSTOMS (BONDED WAREHOUSE) (TORTUGA RUM  
COMPANY LIMITED) REGULATIONS, 2006

In exercise of the powers contained in section 73 of the Customs Law (2003 Revision) the Governor in Cabinet makes the following Regulations:

Citation	1. These Regulations may be cited as the Customs (Bonded Warehouse) (Tortuga Rum Company Limited) Regulations, 2006.
Prescribed warehouse	2. Subject to compliance with the conditions specified in Schedule 2, the premises described in Schedule 1 is a bonded warehouse.
Warehouse keeper	3. The person named in Schedule 3 is nominated to be the warehouse keeper of the warehouse referred to in regulations 2.
Repeal of the Nineteenth Schedule of the Customs (Bonded Warehouses) Regulations (2001 Revision)	4. The Nineteenth Schedule of the Customs (Bonded Warehouses) Regulations (2001 Revision) is repealed.

SCHEDULE 1

The Bonded Warehouse

That part of the building located in North Sound Road Block 20B, Parcel 321, George Town, consisting of an area of 2, 312 square feet more particularly delineated on the plan attached to the request for a resizing of the bonded warehouse made by Robert Hamaty on May 3, 2006.

SCHEDULE 2

The Conditions

That no goods, other than those of Tortuga Rum Company Limited or any of its wholly owned subsidiaries or any of their respective companies, shall be stored in the bonded warehouse.
