In exercise of the powers conferred by sections 22, 23 and 75 of the Customs Law (2007 Revision), the Governor in Cabinet makes the following regulations-

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Customs (Bonded Warehouses) (Amendment) Regulations, 2008. Citation

2. The Customs (Bonded Warehouses) Regulations (2007 Revision) are amended by inserting after the Twenty-Fifth Schedule, the following Schedule - Insertion of new Twenty-sixth Schedule to the Customs (Bonded Warehouses) Regulations (2007 Revision)

“TWENTY-SIXTH SCHEDULE

Part 1

That part of the building at Block 20C, Parcel 15, Store # 12, Airport Plaza, Owen Roberts Drive, George Town, consisting of an area of 861 square feet more particularly delineated on the plan attached to the application for approval of a bonded warehouse made by Damian C. Bancroft of Puro Rey Cigars on July 10, 2007.

Part 2

1. That a bond in the sum of \$30,000 with a recognised bank or insurance company be taken out to cover the duty risk in respect of goods in the bonded warehouse at any time.
2. That no goods, other than cigars which are the property of the Puro Rey Cigars shall be stored in the bonded warehouse.

Damian C. Bancroft”.
