In exercise of the powers conferred by sections 22, 23 and 75 of the Customs Law (2011 Revision), the Governor in Cabinet makes the following Regulations -

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Customs (Bonded Warehouses) (Amendment) Regulations, 2012. Citation

2. The Customs (Bonded Warehouses) Regulations (2011 Revision) are amended by inserting after Schedule 29, the following Schedule - Insertion of Schedule 30

**“SCHEDULE 30**

**Part 1**

That part of the building located at Block 95 Parcel 86CBW, Tibbetts Plaza, 25 Cross Road, Cayman Brac, consisting of an area of 400 square feet more particularly delineated on the plan attached to the application for approval of a bonded warehouse made by Robert Hamaty of Tortuga Rum Company Limited on 27<sup>th</sup> October, 2011.

**Part 2**

1. That a bond in the sum of \$1,050,000 with a recognised bank or insurance company be taken out to cover the duty risk in respect of goods in the bonded warehouse at any time.
2. That no goods, other than wine, spirits, cigarettes and other tobacco products which are the property of Tortuga Rum Company Limited, shall be stored in the bonded warehouse.
