THE CUSTOMS (PROHIBITED GOODS) (AMENDMENT) ORDER, 2012

In exercise of the powers conferred by sections 12 and 75 of the Customs Law (2011 Revision), the Governor in Cabinet makes the following Order -

1. This Order may be cited as the Customs (Prohibited Goods) (Amendment) Order, 2012 and comes into force immediately after the Traffic Law comes into force.

2. The Customs (Prohibited Goods) Order (2003 Revision) is amended by repealing paragraph 7.
