## A LAW TO TEMPORARILY REDUCE VARIOUS DUTIES UNDER THE CUSTOMS TARIFF LAW (2002 REVISION); AND TO MAKE PROVISION FOR RELATED MATTERS

ENACTED by the Legislature of the Cayman Islands.

1. (1) This Law may be cited as the Customs Tariff (Amendment) (Temporary Provisions) Law, 2009.

Short title, commencement and expiry

- (2) This Law comes into force on 1<sup>st</sup> April, 2009 and shall cease to have effect on 1<sup>st</sup> January, 2010.
- (3) Upon the expiration of this Law, the law in force immediately prior to the coming into force of this Law shall, so far as it is amended by this Law, again operate as though this Law had not been passed and the said amendments had not been enacted.
- 2. The Customs Tariff Law (2002 Revision) is amended in the First Schedule, in the column headed "Duty"-

Amendment of First Schedule of the Customs Tariff Law (2002 Revision)

- (a) opposite code number 25.11 by repealing "20%" and substituting "15%":
- (b) opposite code number 44.01 by repealing "15%" and substituting "10%";
- (c) opposite code number 44.11 by repealing "20%" and substituting "15%":

- (d) opposite code number 72.01 by repealing "20%" and substituting "15%": and
- (e) opposite code number 73.01 by repealing "20%" and substituting "15%".
