



## MEMORANDUM OF OBJECTS AND REASONS

It has been found in practice that the time allowed by the Law for making objections to a Development Plan prepared under Part II is insufficient. It is therefore sought to increase the time for making such objections from one month to two months and to amend paragraph (a) of subsection (3) of section 8 in order to achieve this purpose.

## A LAW TO AMEND THE DEVELOPMENT AND PLANNING LAW, 1971

ENACTED by the Legislature of the Cayman Islands.

Short title.

1. This Law may be cited as the Development and Planning (Amendment) Law, 1975.

interpretation.

2. In this Law -

Law 28 of 1971.

"Law" means the Development and Planning Law, 1971;

"section" means a section of the Law.

Section 8 amended.

3. Paragraph (a) of subsection (3) of section 8 is hereby amended by deleting "one month" where the words appear in the third line thereof and substituting the words "two months".
