**A LAW TO AMEND THE DISASTER PREPAREDNESS AND HAZARD
MANAGEMENT LAW 2016, LAW 46 OF 2016; TO AMEND CERTAIN
DEFINITIONS; TO ESTABLISH THE NATIONAL DISASTER FUND
AND TO PROVIDE FOR NOTIFICATION OF SUDDEN ONSET
EVENTS; AND FOR INCIDENTAL AND CONNECTED PURPOSES**

ENACTED by the Legislature of the Cayman Islands.

1. This Law may be cited as the Disaster Preparedness and Hazard Management (Amendment) Law, 2018. Short title
2. The Disaster Preparedness and Hazard Management Law, 2016, Law 46 of 2016, in this Law referred to as the “principal Law”, is amended in section 2 in the definition of the word “Ministry” by deleting the words “Home Affairs” and substituting the words “the Department of Hazard Management Cayman Islands”. Amendment of section 2 of the Disaster Preparedness and Hazard Management Law, 2016, Law 46 of 2016 - definitions
3. The principal Law is amended by inserting after section 4 the following section - Insertion of section 4A - establishment of the National Disaster Fund
 - “Establishment 4A. (1) There is established the National Disaster

of the National Disaster Fund Fund, into which is to be paid monies from the sources specified in Schedule 2.

(2) The Cabinet may by Regulation amend Schedule 2 and such Regulations are subject to the negative resolution of the Legislative Assembly.

(2018 Revision) (3) The National Disaster Fund shall form part of the discretionary reserve of the finances of the core Government under the Public Management and Finance Law (2018 Revision).

(4) Pursuant to this Law, the Management Executive shall advise the Cabinet on the use of the Fund and shall be responsible for the management of monies disbursed from the Fund to carry out any of the activities required to give effect to the purposes of the Fund as directed by the Cabinet.”.

Amendment of section 6 - responsibilities of the Director

4. The principal Law is amended in section 6(3) by inserting after the words “Department’s activities” the words “and the manner in which the monies from the National Disaster Fund were utilised”.

Amendment of section 8 - National Emergency Notification System

5. The principal Law is amended in section 8 as follows -

- (a) in subsection (1) by deleting the words “a broadcasting station under the Information and Communications Technology Authority Law (2011 Revision)” and substituting the words “an ICT network under the Information and Communication Technology Law (2017 Revision)”; and
- (b) by deleting subsection (2) and substituting the following subsections -

“(2) No announcement shall be broadcast on the National Emergency Notification System unless it is in writing and approved and signed by a Chairman of the Management Executive or the Chairman of the Management Council in consultation with the Director, except in the event of a sudden onset event specified in subsection (2A).

(2A) In the event of a sudden onset event like a tsunami or an earthquake, which requires swift notification to the public, the Director of The Department of Hazard Management Cayman

Islands may authorise the broadcast of an emergency announcement and shall notify a Chairman of the Management Executive or the Chairman of the Management Council of the broadcast as soon as is practicable thereafter.”.

6. The principal Law is amended in section 14(2) by deleting the words “the Schedule” wherever these words appear and substituting the words “Schedule 1”.

Amendment of section 14 - National Hazard Management Executive and Council

7. The principal Law is amended in the Schedule as follows -

Amendment of the Schedule - organisation and composition of Management Executive and Management Council

- (a) in the heading by renumbering the Schedule as Schedule 1;
- (b) in part A, in paragraph 3 as follows -
 - (i) in subparagraph (a) by deleting the words “- Chairman”;
 - (ii) in subparagraph (g) by deleting the words “of Home Affairs” and substituting the words “with responsibility for the Department of Hazard Management Cayman Islands”;
 - and
 - (iii) by inserting after subparagraph (k) the following -
“(l) all Ministers of the Cabinet,
and shall be co-chaired by the Governor and the Premier.”; and
- (c) in part B, in paragraph 7 as follows -
 - (i) in subparagraph (b) by deleting the words “of Home Affairs” and substituting the words “with responsibility for the Department of Hazard Management Cayman Islands”;
 - (ii) in subparagraph (n) by deleting the words “Office of Telecommunications” and substituting the words “Department of Public Safety Communications”; and
 - (iii) by inserting after subparagraph (dd) the following subparagraph -
“(ee) Director, Her Majesty’s Cayman Islands Prison Service”.

8. The principal Law is amended by inserting after Schedule 1 the following Schedule -

Insertion of Schedule 2 - composition of the National Disaster Fund

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SCHEDULE 2

(Section 4A)

NATIONAL DISASTER FUND

The National Disaster Fund is comprised of -

- (a) an annual allotment of a sum which may not be less than four hundred thousand dollars from the general revenues of the Island;
- (b) appropriations from the revenue, borrowings or other funds of the Government in accordance with the Public Management and Finance Law (2018 Revision);
- (c) earnings from interest on or dividends on investment of the fund;
- (d) any surplus in the annual budget allocation of Hazard Management Cayman Islands at year-end; and
- (e) any contribution or grant by an individual, organisation or government paid to the Government for the benefit of the National Disaster Fund.”.
