THE EXEMPTED LIMITED PARTNERSHIP REGULATIONS, 2014

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 48 of the Exempted Limited Partnership Law, 2014 (Law 5 of 2014), the Cabinet makes the following Regulations -

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Exempted Limited Partnership Citation Regulations, 2014.

2. The fees set out in Schedule 1 shall be paid to the Registrar in respect of exempted limited partnerships and foreign limited partnerships.

3. For the purposes of section 42(1) of the Law, the recognized jurisdictions are set out in Schedule 2. Recognised jurisdictions Schedule 2

4. The form for the grant of an undertaking under section 38(3) of the Law is Schedule 3. Form of undertaking set out in Schedule 3.

5. The administrative fees set out in Schedule 4 shall be paid to the Registrar in respect of exempted limited partnerships and foreign limited partnerships.
