(REVISED)

GEORGE TOWN MARKET REGULATIONS, 1978

In exercise of the powers conferred upon the Governor in Council by section 14 of the above Law the following Regulations are hereby made —

- Citation.
- Market hours.
- Meat to be sold by
avoirduois weight.
- Restrictions of sale
of meat in neigh-
bourhood of market.
- Fees payable on
carcasses in-
troduced.
1. These Regulations have application to George Town Market and may be cited as the George Town Market Regulations, 1978.
2. George Town Market shall be open to the public during the following hours —

8.00a.m. — 5.00p.m.
Beef and Turtle Sections open at varied hours
3. The sale of meat in the market shall be by avoirdupois weights.
4. No butchers' meat, that is to say, beef, mutton, pork, goat or turtle shall be sold or exposed for sale outside the market at George Town within two miles radius thereof other than by establishments licensed in that behalf under the Trade and Business Licensing Law (Revised).
5. Fees per carcass brought to Market for sale at the following rates —

Beef \$5.00
Mutton or Lamb \$2.00
Pork \$2.00
Goat \$2.00
Turtle \$2.00

are payable to the Market Master at the time of introduction of such carcasses into the Market.

- Mode of paying
market rentals.
6. Persons renting or leasing Market premises or part thereof shall pay to the Market Master an annual rental of \$2.40 per square foot of space occupied, payable in monthly instalments in advance. Such revenue is to be paid by the Market Master into the Government Treasury not later than two working days after receipt.
