#### The Grand Court (Amendment) Law, 2005

Amendment of section 7 3. - Officers of the Court The principal Law is amended in section 7 -

- (a) in subsection (1) by repealing the words "The Governor, in accordance with the Public Service Commission Law (Revised)" and substituting therefor the words "The chief officer, in accordance with the Public Service Management Law, 2005,";
- (b) in subsection (2) by repealing the word "Governor" and substituting therefor the word "chief officer".
