**A LAW TO AMEND THE GRAND COURT LAW (2006 REVISION) IN
ORDER TO CHANGE THE DATES OF THE SESSIONS OF THE
COURT; AND FOR INCIDENTAL AND CONNECTED PURPOSES**

ENACTED by the Legislature of the Cayman Islands.

1. This Law may be cited as the Grand Court (Amendment) Law, 2007.

Short title

2. The Grand Court Law (2006 Revision) is amended by repealing section 21 and substituting the following section-

Repeal of section 21 of the Grand Court Law (2006 Revision) and substitution- sessions of the Court

“Sessions of the Court

21. (1) The Court shall convene quarterly sessions for the trial of both civil and criminal cases and such sessions shall-

- (a) commence in the month of January of each year; and
- (b) continue until the business of the Court is completed.

(2) The Chief Justice shall, by notice published in the Gazette on or by the 1st December of each year, give notice of the date on which each quarterly session shall commence during the following year.”.

Transitional provisions

3. The Chief Justice shall, by notice published in the Gazette, on or by 16th December 2007, give notice of the date on which each quarterly session shall commence in 2008.
